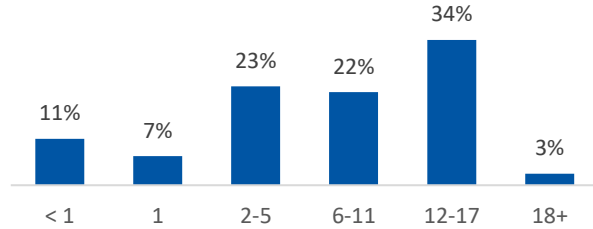

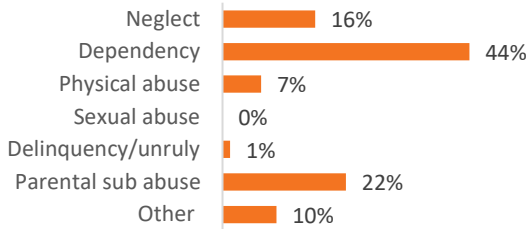

Age in Years



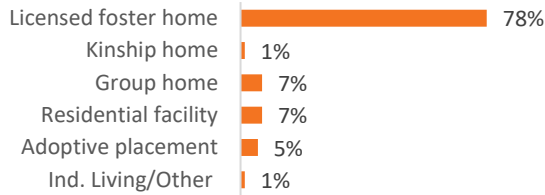
Primary Reason for Removal



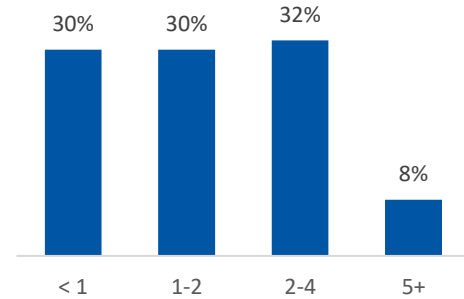
Type of Custody

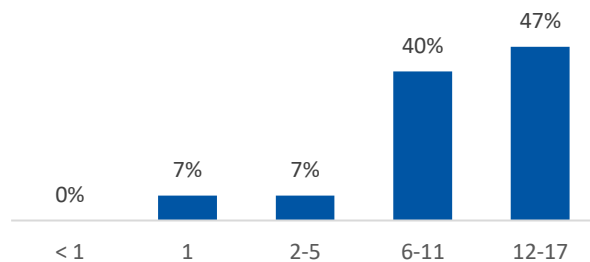
